I am so delighted to announce that the documentary *Through the Heart of Tango* was selected to be featured on PBS SoCal!

*Through the Heart of Tango* is a story about four special needs young men from Los Angeles, three with Autism, one with Down Syndrome that take a journey through dance and discover a whole new world of friendship and connection. The film features one of the world's leading tango performers and choreographers Miriam Larici and Leonardo Barrionuevo who share their "tango love".

*Through the Heart of Tango* will air on **Sunday, July 27<sup>th</sup> at 7pm and on Saturday, August 2 at 4am** (for all you late night milongueros who are just coming home). PBS SoCaL (<http://www.pbssocal.org/home/>) will be airing the show on the "plus" channel, you can watch on broadcast channel 50.2, Time Warner Cable channel 1267, Cox Cable channel 810, Charter Cable channel 314, and Verizon FIOS channel 470. Additional broadcast dates will be determined at a later time.

In late August, I will be traveling to the Czech Republic to participate in a mini workshop for families at the Auticenter (<http://www.autiste-jihu.cz/>) and to present a public screening of the documentary. A big "thank you" to the wonderful team and organizers in CZ – colleagues from the University of South Bohemia, the Auticenter, and the tango community of Ceske Budejovice who are promoting the film and providing translation support for the documentary, and to Prof. Zuzana Bic at UCI and The Center for Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders for their ongoing support of this project.
